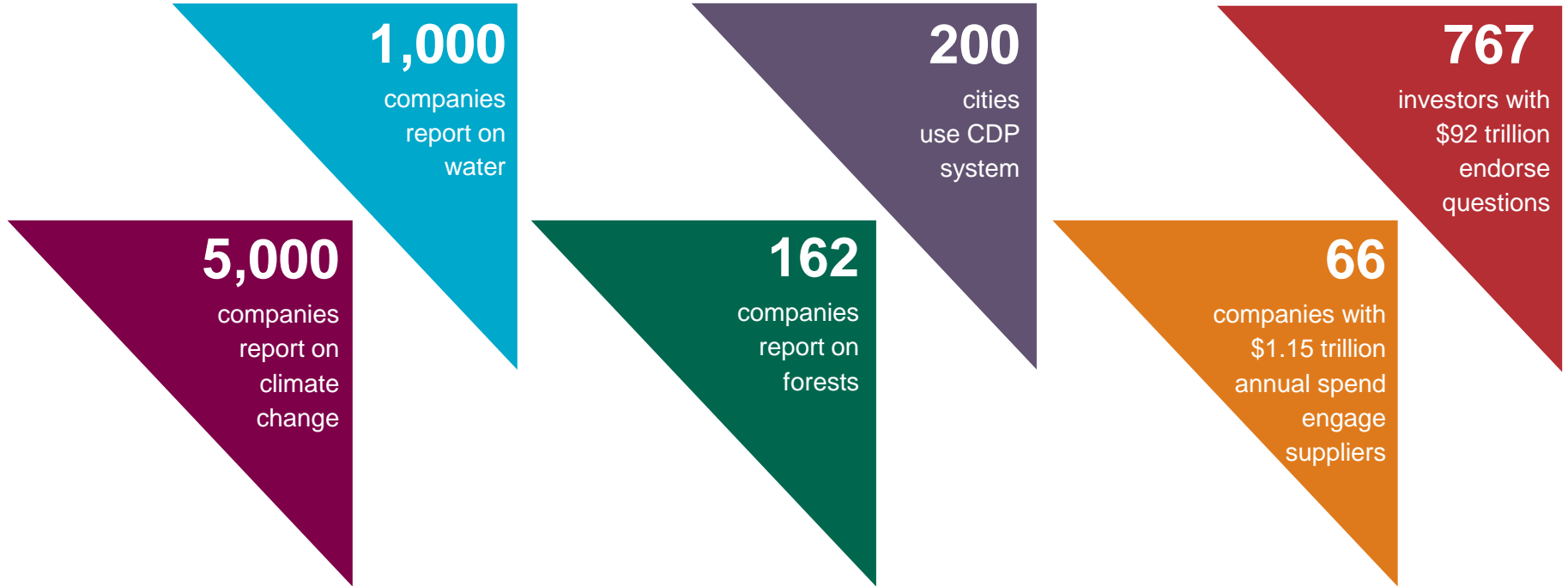

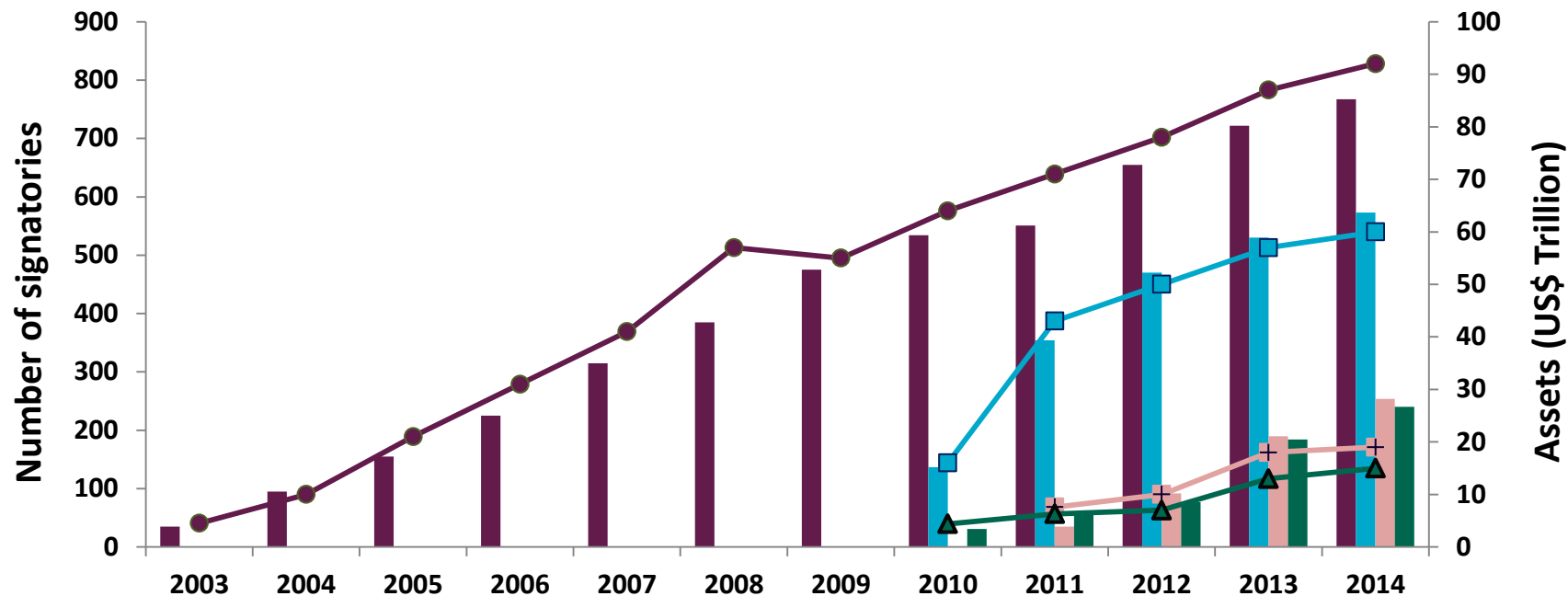
Carbon emissions are set to reach a 40 billion metric ton high... this year.

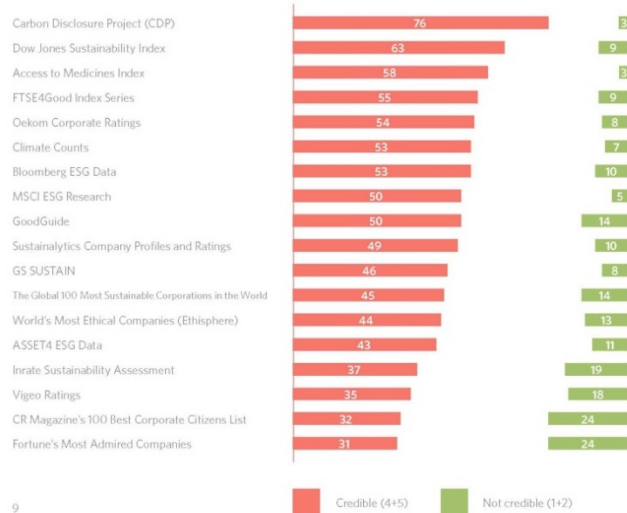

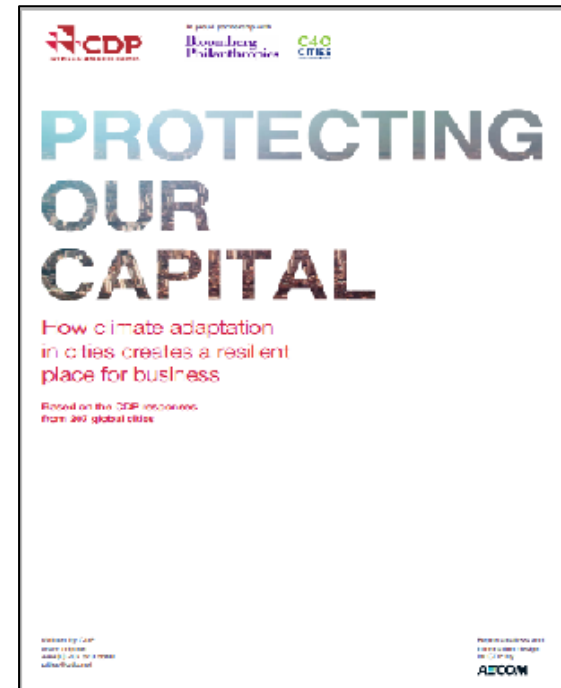
How credible do you find the following ratings and rankings to be?

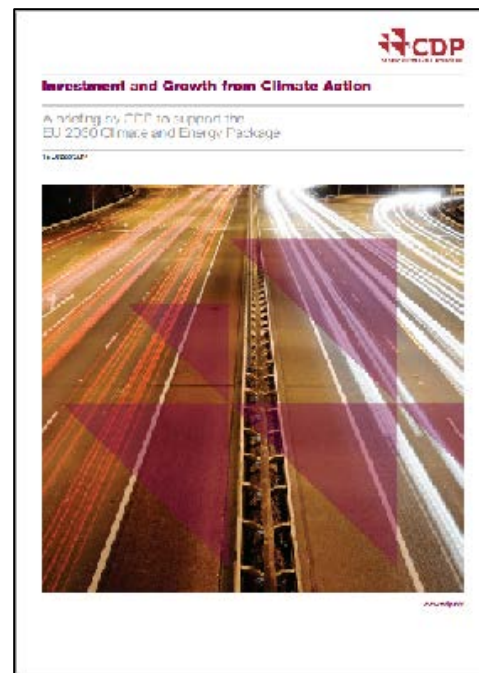
