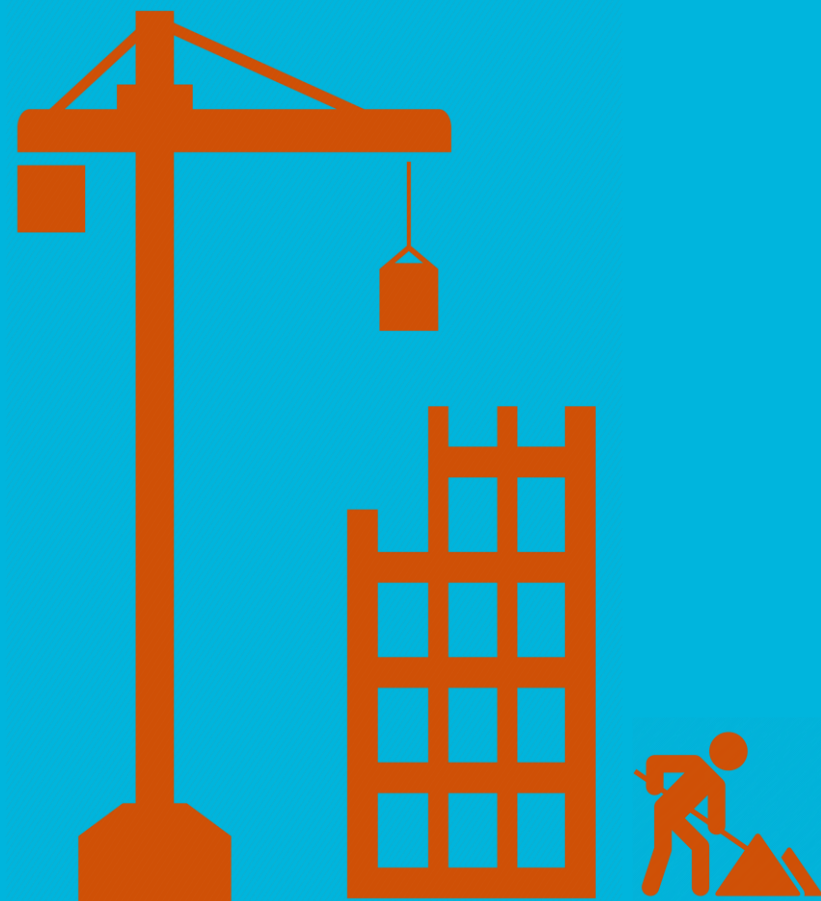


IN LAC TODAY

- In LAC, 80 million people lack access to water and sanitation...
- ... 30 million lack electricity, while 17% of the electricity generated each year is lost.
- LAC must fill an infrastructure financing gap of US\$100 billion a year over the next decade...
- And because 70% of the forecasted emissions increase in developing countries is expected to come from infrastructure that's yet to be built, we must invest in sustainable infrastructure specifically.

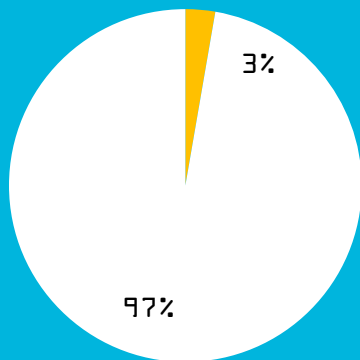

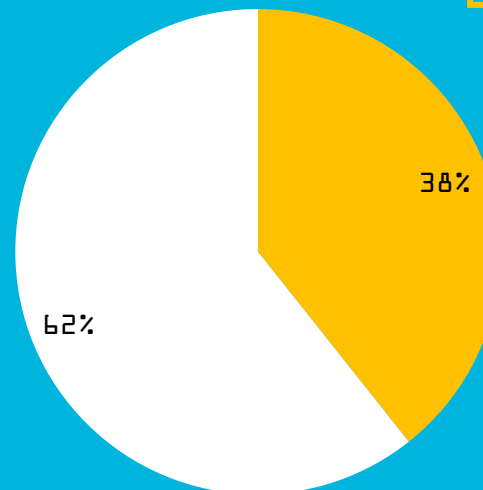
